We are keeping our fingers crossed that in person programming will be available in the upcoming months!

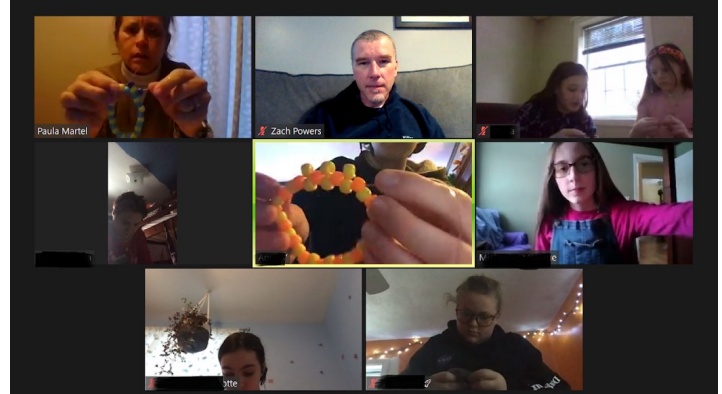
