How old do you have to be to join PYW?

Youth in grades 6-12 are able to join PYW, we do not set participation requirements based on age, and youth can come from any town – although the majority of our members live in Pittsfield. Youth entering 6th grade in the fall can participate now.

Is the center supervised?
